Authors are expected to actively participate in the review process and respond to reviewer comments in a timely and constructive manner. Likewise, reviewers must maintain confidentiality and provide objective and fair evaluations.

Correction of Errors: If authors discover a significant error in their published work, they are expected to notify the conference organizers promptly and collaborate to issue a correction or retraction if necessary.

Respect and Professionalism: All participants are expected to engage with respect and professionalism. Critiques should be constructive and focused on the content of the work presented.
